Every day I hear stories from people who are not comfortable with their dog's behaviour. In most cases it's not that the dog is nasty or aggressive, it's just that the pet's behaviour is in some ways just not quite acceptable or quite as it should be.

To try and document exactly what the pet owner is concerned about I've developed this short questionnaire. So that I can help you, please complete it to the best of your ability by simply circling the appropriate answer in the right-hand column.

The following short honesty check will tell you "Who's the boss" in your household.

1) If you and the dog arrive at the door together, who walks through the door first?	Me	Dog
